The Cathedral Public Library was founded in the 1970s and began to function on 1 October 1979. It has now over 140,000 books.

As part of an EU funded project called ReBeL, a project within the Grundivig programme, the Cathedral Public Library is organising a series of activities to encourage students to visit the library and to read books.

The following is the programme of activities that will take place when the students visit our library:

- Library Orientation by Mr. Anton Farrugia (librarian)
- Years 1 to 3 Storytelling, followed by an activity related to the narrated story.
- Years 4 to 6 Worksheet about the library to be carried out by groups of students.
- Break: Sandwich and fruit juice to each visiting student
- Choice of ONE book per student. Students will be allowed to take ONE book, chosen by themselves, back to their respective schools. They will also be allowed to keep the books in their classes for ONE month. Books will then be collected by our librarians.
- Book raffle ONE book per group
- Membership fee will be reduced from €5 to €2 for the attending students for the first year.

Activity takes approximately 2hours.
